

# Terms of use

These Terms of Use are applicable to all users of this C4DCH. Users should read, understand and accept these Terms when accessing this C4DCH. If a given user has not done this, or does not agree with the contents of these Terms of Use, that user should not create an account on the Website and should not make use of any of the services provided via this C4DCH.

- Online content management of CH archives and collections, with support of meta-data and OCR for Latin characters.
- Manage and share online 3D models and GIS data visualisation.
- Run Agent Based Modelling for modelling complex system interactions

Metadata can follow the CIDOC-CRM RDF, or ARC2 triple store, ISBD –M, and UNIMARC standards. Metadata standardization, e.g., Dublin Core, should be applied.
